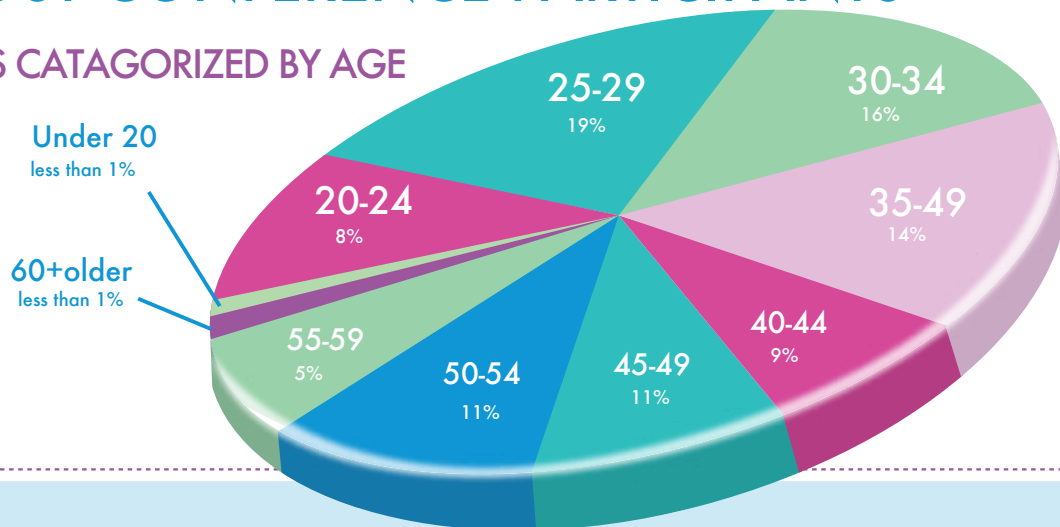

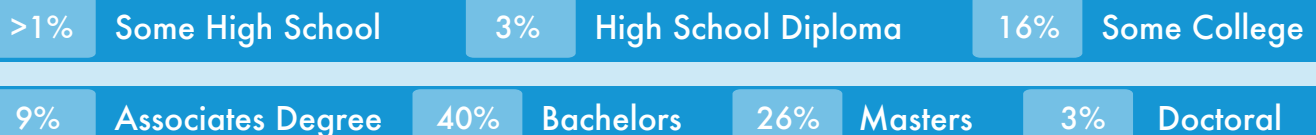

PARTICIPANTS CATAGORIZED BY AGE



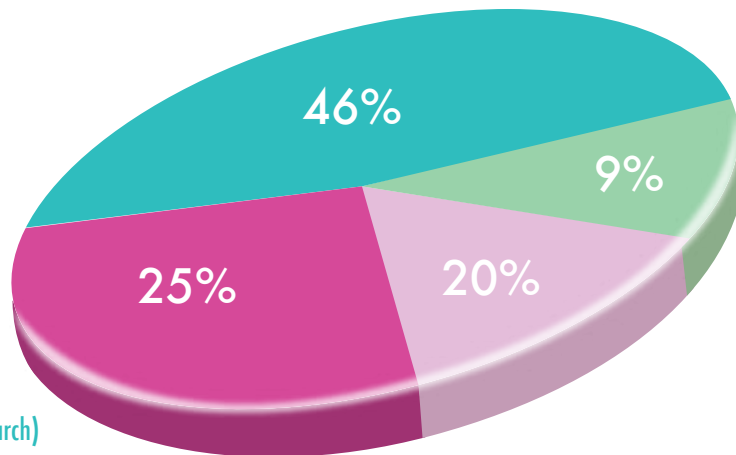
PARTICIPANTS CATAGORIZED BY HIGHEST LEVEL OF EDUCATION

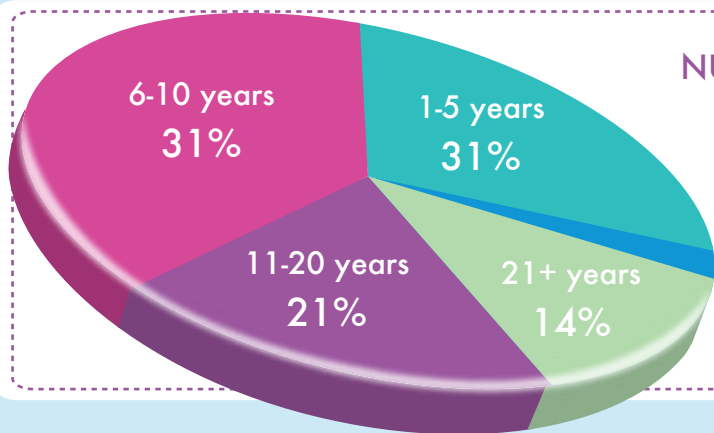
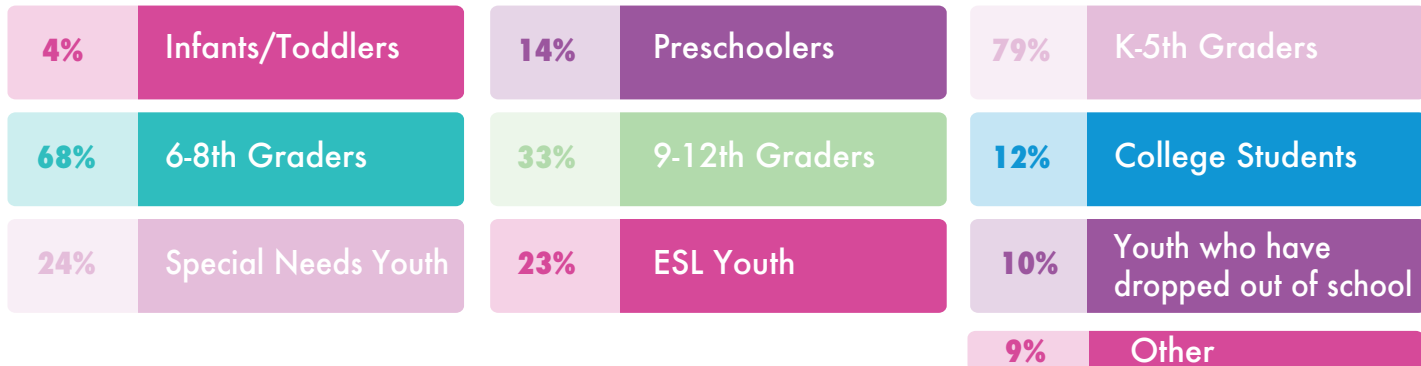
- 25%** **Upper-Level Administration**
