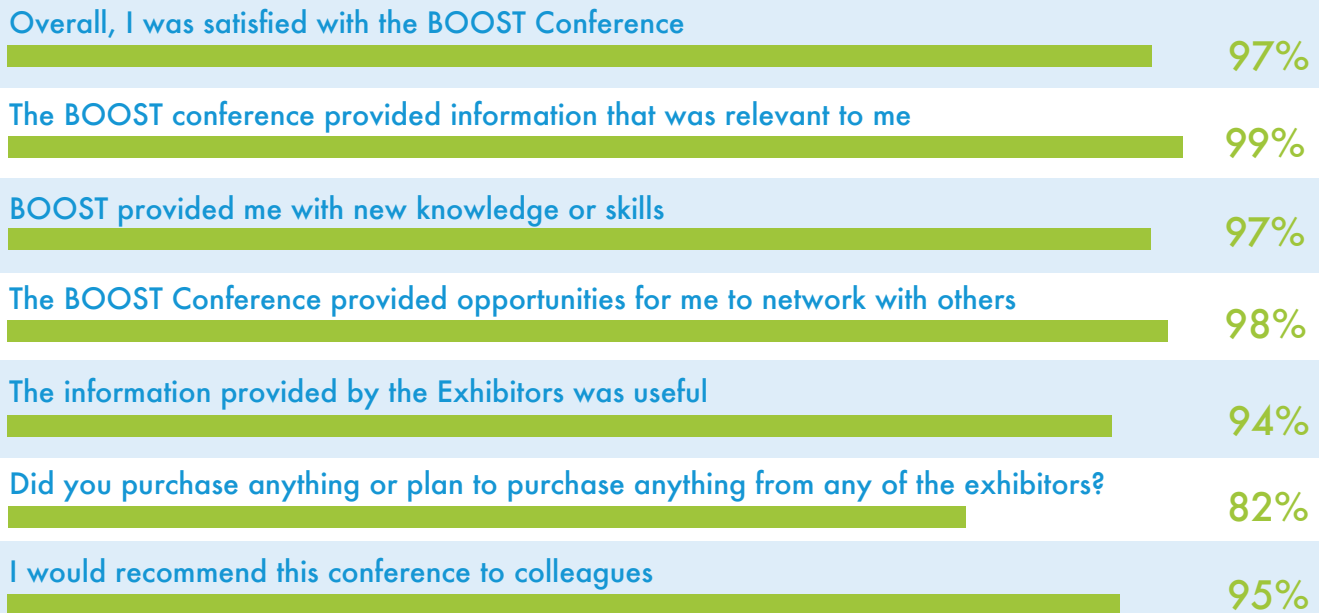
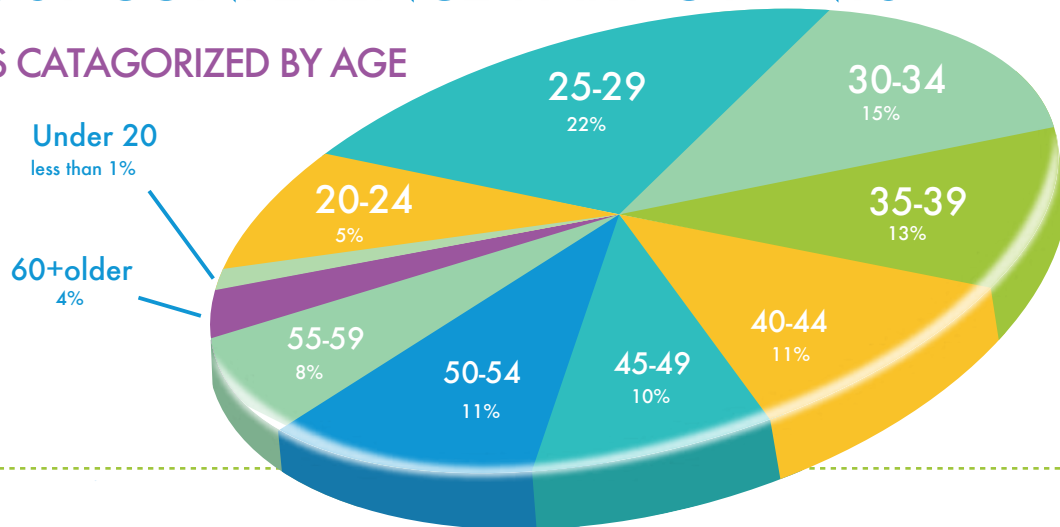

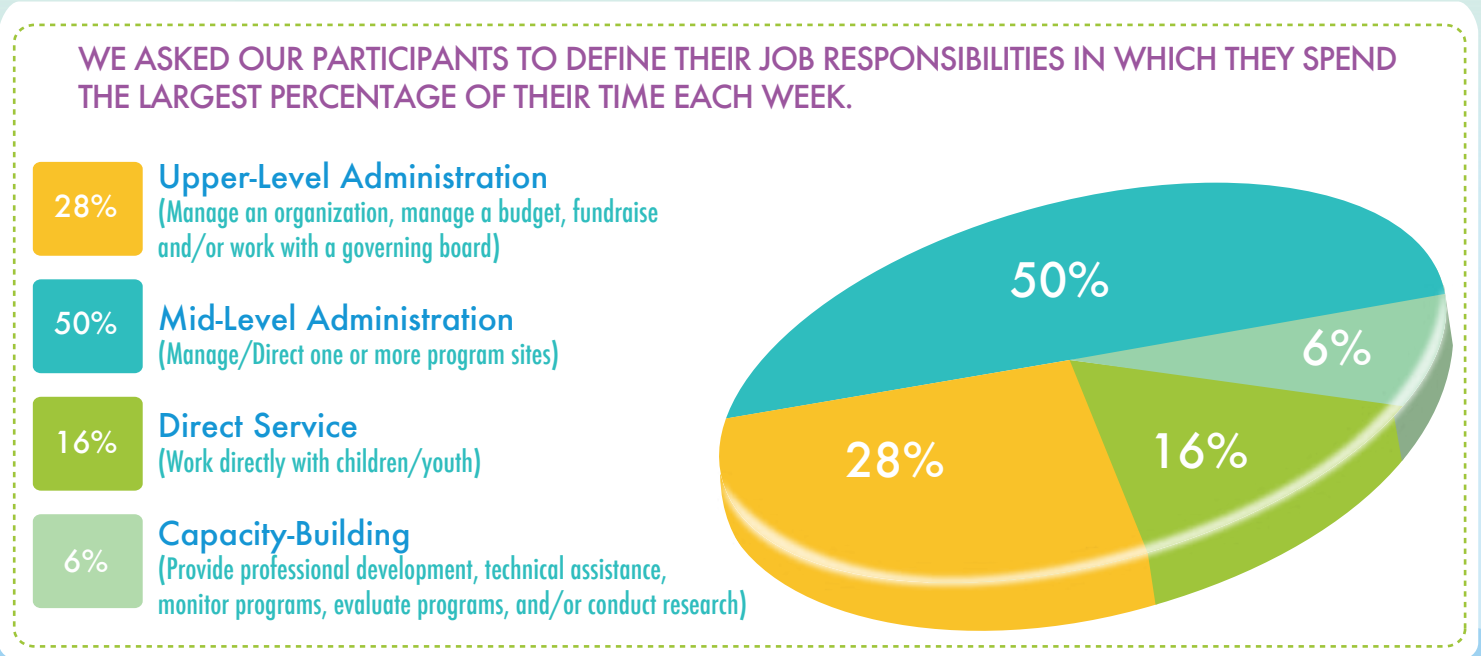
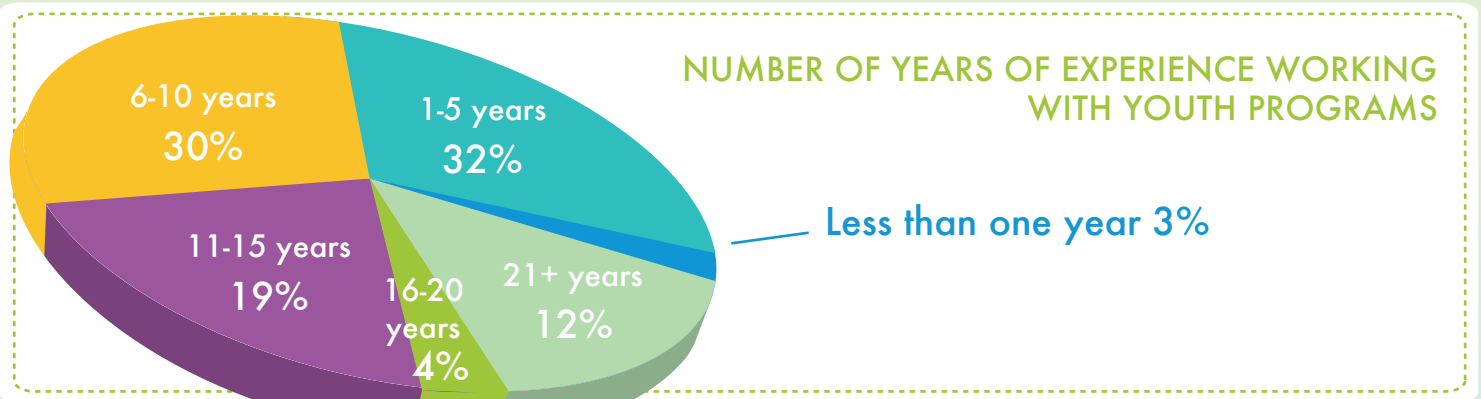
PARTICIPANTS CATAGORIZED BY AGE



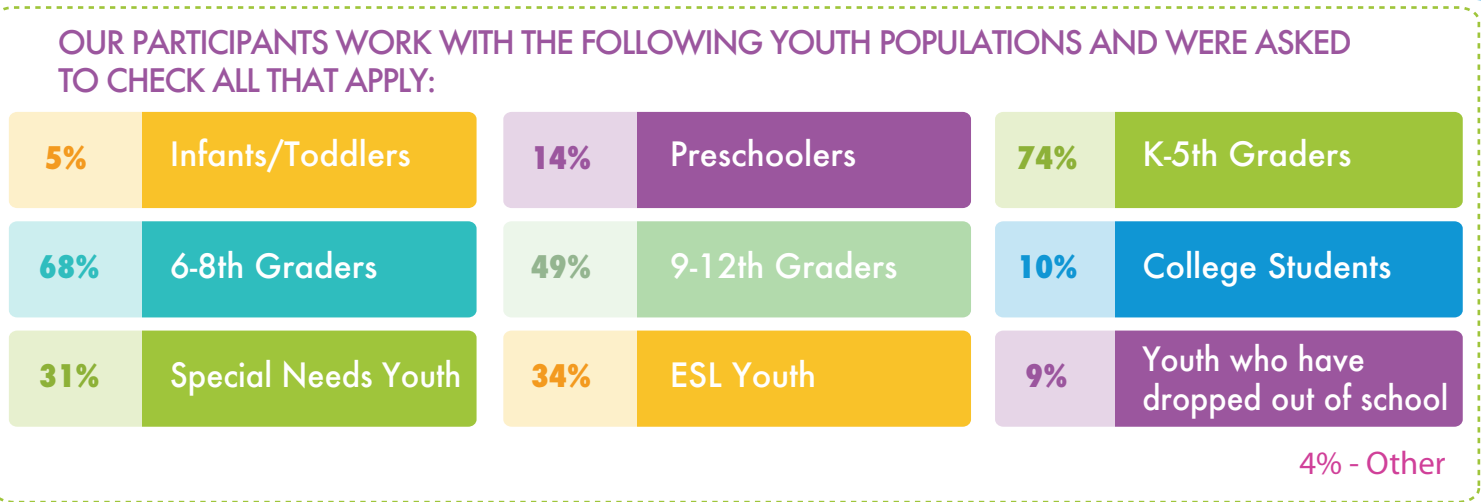
PARTICIPANTS CATAGORIZED BY HIGHEST LEVEL OF EDUCATION

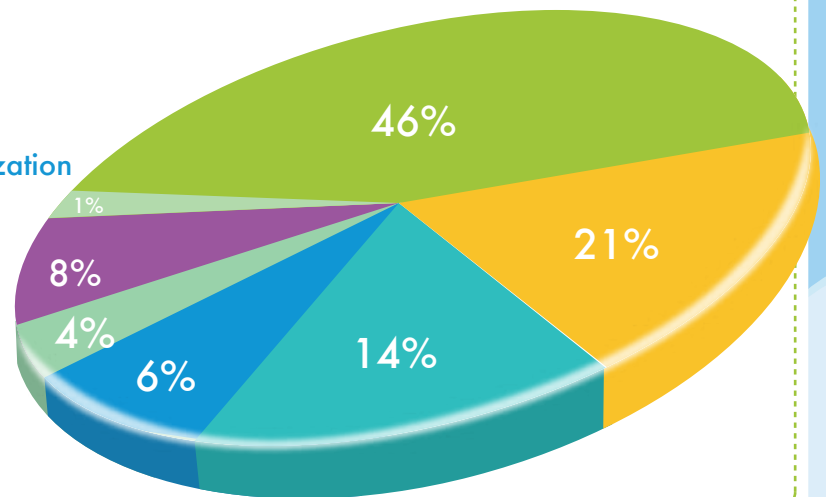
